The City of American Falls Water Department encourages our customers to develop water conserving habits. When you conserve water, you preserve a precious natural resource. Water consumption increases by at least 65% during the summer. Here are some simple things you can do to help conserve water.

- Water the lawn deeply and infrequently during the coolest time of the day to promote a deep root system
- Avoid watering when it is windy, hot or raining
- Make sure your hose bib shuts off
- Avoid over watering.
- Repair leaks! Dripping faucets and broken pipes can waste gallons of water
- Use a broom, not a hose to clean off your sidewalks and driveways.
